This is done annually through a self-assessment survey in which the board responds to twelve criteria: Institutional Mission; Academic Governance and Educational Policies; Institutional Planning; Board/Chief Executive Relationships; Physical Plant; Financial Management; Financial Support; Board Membership; Board Organization and Performance; Board Relations with Key Constituents; Accountability to the Pubic; and Accreditation.

Each regent also assesses its own commitment and performance through a checklist designed to help assess and reflect on board service and the expectations generally held for all board members.
