Early Admission

The college provides post secondary instructional opportunities to eligible high school students by offering an Early Admission Program for academically talented high school students who are ready to benefit from college and want to enter college in advance of high school graduation.

Students are eligible for early admission if they meet all of the following requirements:

- 1. The student provides a certification from the local principal and/or his/her designee certifying that the student has a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5, and recommending that the student be admitted under the college's Early Admission Policy.
- 2. The student has successfully completed the 11th grade.
- 3. The student has satisfied the college's Recruitment, Admissions and Retention Committee (RARC) recommendation via the COMET, and has been placed into college level (100) English courses in both reading and writing.

The student enrolled through Early Admission is not eligible for Federal Financial Aid assistance until a high school diploma or equivalent has been achieved.

The student must submit (a) a completed College of Micronesia-FSM Application for Early Admission to the Office of Admissions, Records and Retention; (b) recommendation letter from the principal or designee; (c) proof of paying the admission fee; and (d) a high school transcript that verifies criteria one and two above. These documents must be submitted together as one packet.
