## **Admission Requirements**

Applicants must meet the following admission requirements to be matriculated into a degree program:

- 1. Have graduated or will graduate from high school at the end of the current school year, or have a General Educational Development (GED) certificate, or have a HiSET high school equivalency credential;
- 2. Have a minimum high school grade point average of 2.0 as measured on a 4.0 scale, or a minimal score of 35 on each section and an average score of 45 for all five sections of the GED test; or a minimum score of 8 on each of the five individual subtest of the HiSET exam with a score of at least 2 out of 6 on the essay portion of the writing test and a total combined score on all five HiSET subtest of at least 45; and
- 3. Be accepted by the Committee on Recruitment, Admissions and Retention.
