- 1. Board Policy 4500 (Early Warning Deficiency) without any modifications or revisions.
- 2. Board Policy 4408 (Change to Student Schedule) with modification to include the phrase "After the regular registration period" on the first sentence.

On September 3, 2018, the Recruitment, Admissions, and Retention Committee (RARC) reviewed and endorsed:

 Board Policy 4501 (Mid-Term Deficiency Notices) with modifications or revisions to include: (a) change to the policy's title from "Mid-Term Deficiency Notices" to "Mid-Term Deficiency Grades;" (b) include the clause "and submit all mid-term grades to the Office of Admissions, Records and Retention" on the first sentence; and (c) strike out the clause "and are reported to the admission office" on the second sentence.
