Program Deletion

Program review and evaluation processes may indicate that an instructional program is not viable and should be eliminated from College offerings; the program needs to be deleted. Deletion refers only to those programs that will not likely be offered again; it does not refer to those programs that may be offered on a cyclical basis and have periods of inactivity. While programs may be removed from the catalog, specific courses will remain on the "List of Active Courses" for transcribing purposes.

Another option is to delete this as a policy since we have the policy on program review (BP 3202 – just reviewed in March, but procedures need to be same as CC handbook [EC review]). The handbook describes the procedure for program review. A section could be added to describe a recommendation for deletion of a program.
