Activities and Highlights:

The Faculty and Staff Senate will continue to work within the established committee structure to effectively engage in promoting the shared governance policy and procedures in addressing employee issues and concerns.

The Human Resource Committee has proposed an effective routing procedure to promote a shared governance environment with the FS Senate and the college community. The proposed routing procedure will enhance communications in gathering feedbacks toward any recommendation write ups prior to the next level, the HRO Director. The FS Senate Engagement Template which was adopted and approved by the FS Executive Committee will be launched soon on line in monkey survey to allow sufficient access and effectiveness in gathering meaningful inputs and issue prioritization.

The FS Senate Executive Committee is looking forward to work with other standing committees to promote the shared governance policy and finding ways to actively engage the employees in the participatory governance.
